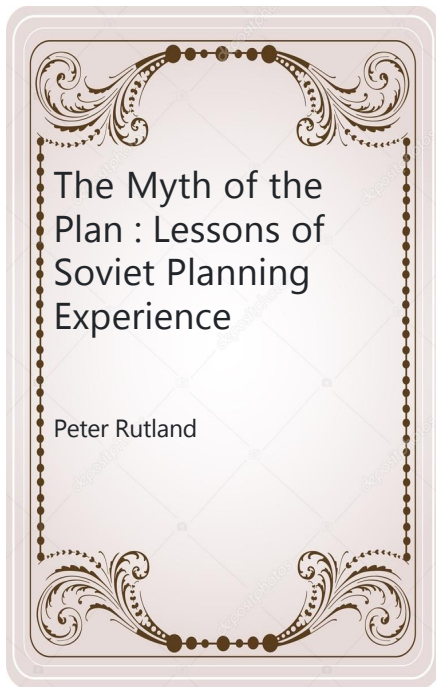


The Myth of the Plan : Lessons of Soviet Planning Experience
